

Deer's medicine teaches us gentleness in word, thought and touch. The ability to listen, grace and appreciation for the beauty of balance. Understanding of what's necessary for survival, power of gratitude and giving, ability to sacrifice for the higher good.

We honor deer in this beautiful wall hanging by using a deer jawbone, and deer hide.

Students will adorn the bone with various stones, embroidery appliqué, and beads.

There are no color ways for this kit as the students will choose the stones, embroidered flowers, leather fringe, metal cones and fir scrap from a large selection.

Students will learn how to use embroidery appliqué in their bead work, laying out your design, adding cones to the fringe and or tassel, bead embroidery techniques.

Supplies needed for class

Good scissors, small pliers
Beading thread and needle for size 15 beads
Aleene's Super Thick Tacky Glue
E6000 or two part Epoxy glue
Paint brush if you want to paint the deers teeth. Heidi will provide the paint.

Supplies included in kit

Beads size 15 and size 9 cut gold iris (Heidi Beads) Ginko beads ultra suede foundation chain for hanging
Jawbone
Leather fringe, cones, stones,
fur, embroidered flower applique,
paint.
